ENROLLMENT

You can sign up for the courses on the Internet (www.kaskikuusi.fi), by phone (tel 040-488 3202) or by visiting the office. For all study groups, an advance registration is required and binding. CENTRE'S WORKING YEAR

Teaching starts generally on week 38. Music instrument lessons and solo singing start on week 37. The starting dates are given under the study group information in the program.

Autumn semester 16th September–8th December (11 weeks), except the above mentioned music instrument lessons and solo singing 9th September–8th December (12 weeks) – Autumn break 14th October–20th October (week 42)

Spring semester generally 13th January–12th April (12 weeks), physical exercise and dance courses on Tuesday 7th January–12th April (13 weeks) and the above mentioned music instrument lessons and solo singing 7th January–19th April (14 weeks) – Winter break 2nd March–8th March (week 10)

STUDY GROUP FEES AND DISCOUNTS

The basic study group fee is 1,50€ or 2,00€/hour. Music instrument lessons and solo singing are priced differently. To pay the study group fee, each student will receive a bill by mail. If a student signs up for a course (which has begun early in the autumn 2019) after 1.1.2020 the student has to pay only 50% of the study fee. For the school year 2019–2020 Kaskikuusi Adult Education Centre has applied some grant money, which is meant to help immigrants, unemployed people, over 63 year old seniors and under 63 year old pensioners.
